



Improvements to the MEBAC

Existing \$300 health spending account to be included with the new \$600 wellness account,

Starting in 2027, two further improvements will also take effect, including: Increase in vision coverage from \$400 to \$500, per covered person Annual increase in dental coverage by \$250, per covered person
